North Mason Auxiliary #4226 Scholarship Fund

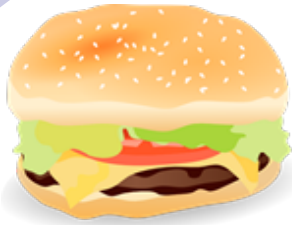
